Objectives

- II. To ensure adherence to ethical standards in all research activities.
- III. To provide guidance on the research process, including proposal submission, supervision, and publication.
- IV. To support collaborative research and interdisciplinary studies.

Research area

The college encourages research in diverse disciplines, including but not limited to:

- Soil conservation
- Soil science

Research Ethics

All research work must be original, with proper citations and acknowledgments. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.

Research Process

- Students must submit a detailed research proposal (synopsis) to their respective departments.

- Proposals should include objectives, methodology, expected outcomes and references.
- The supervisor will review and approve the proposals.
- For Ph.d students, supervisor will be allotted by CSJM University ruling but for P.G students, supervisor will be assigned to complete their research work/dissertation as described in NEP-2020.
- Regular meetings between students and supervisors are mandatory.
- Supervisors are responsible for guiding students through all stages of research.
- Students must submit progress reports at regular intervals as determined by the department.
- The Research Committee will review these reports to ensure timely progress.
- Research committee will strictly adhere to the rules and regulations issued by CSJM University Kanpur from time to time.

Research Publication

Students and faculty members are encouraged to publish their research findings in reputed journals and conferences and publications must acknowledge the affiliation with Janta College, Bakewar, and Etawah.

Research Funding

Management committee Janta College Bakewar Etawah has made a provision of research fund of rupees 600000/- per year for promotion of research activities among the professors.

7. Other expenditures	60,000/-


Grievance Redressal


